In addition, any member who wishes to take part in cycling activities is required to have either a racing or non-racing license from Cycling Ireland or the Irish Veterans Cycling Association.


Details of insurance cover, license fees and an application form for Cycling Ireland are enclosed.

How to join Bray Wheelers

Simply complete and return the enclosed Bray Wheelers application form, together with the appropriate fee, (subscriptions levels overleaf) to:

Please make cheques payable to Bray Wheelers, and please don't send cash by post.

NB: Don't forget, any member who wishes to take part in cycling activities is required to have either a racing or non-racing license from Cycling Ireland or the Irish Veterans Cycling Association.

How to apply for a Cycling Ireland license

Once you are a member of Bray Wheelers, you can then apply for a Cycling Ireland license.

We request that you use the traditional paper application form, rather than the online system, due to problems experienced last year.

Just fill out the enclosed Cycling Ireland application form, choosing the license which you feel suits the type of activities you will be engaged in (see list of fees below) and enclose payment, in favour of Bray Wheelers (please don't make your cheque out to Cycling Ireland!). If its your first license you will need to make sure you supply a photocopy (as it will not be returned) of birth cert, drivers license or passport.

NB: Please remember to sign the back of the form and if you are under 18 years of age, have a guardian give consent also. This year Bray Wheelers intend the send Cycling Ireland license applications off in batches. The following dates are when the license applications need to be submitted.

- First batch** All license applications received on or before **Thursday 17th January 2008**
There will be a meeting in the clubhouse on 8pm on Thurs 17th Jan 2008, for anyone who wishes to bring their applications along. Those wishing to race are requested to get their applications to the secretary on or before this date.
- Second batch** All license applications received on or before **Thursday 31st January 2008**
- Third batch** All license applications received on or before **Thursday 14th February 2008**
- Fourth batch** All license applications received on or before **Thursday 28th February 2008**
- Subsequent** All license applications received on or before **the last day of each month**
