Re: Subscriptions for 2012

Dear member,

It's that time of year when the club asks for the annual subscription. The subscription fees for 2012 will remain unchanged from last year and the 2012 subscription levels are as follows:

■ Adult – Racing	€50.00	■ Under 16 Years	€20.00
■ Adult – Leisure	€40.00	■ Under 14 years	Free
■ Under 18 Years	€30.00	■ Life member (by election)	Free

To participate in open and club races, you need to take out Adult – Racing membership.

Please note, that if you select Adult – Racing membership, that you will be required to marshal at least one of the club races.

As agreed at the 2010 Bray Wheelers AGM, all members are required to assist at one of the open races held by the club. As part of the membership renewal for 2012, we are asking members to indicate which event they will support. The two open events being held in 2012 are:

- Shay Elliott Memorial, Sunday 13th May 2012
- Christy McManus Memorial, Saturday 9th June 2012

In addition, any member who wishes to take part in cycling activities is required to have either a racing or non-competition license from Cycling Ireland or the Irish Veterans Cycling Association. Details of on how to apply for a Cycling Ireland license are enclosed.



How to join Bray Wheelers

Simply complete and return the enclosed Bray Wheelers application form, together with the appropriate fee, (subscriptions levels overleaf) to:

NB: Don't forget, any member who wishes to take part in cycling activities is required to have either a racing or non-competition license from Cycling Ireland or the Irish Veterans Cycling Association.

How to apply for a Cycling Ireland license

Once you are a member of Bray Wheelers, you can then apply for a Cycling Ireland license. There are two options for applying for a Cycling Ireland license

- 1** Use the online system at www.cyclingireland.ie. The online system was successfully used by a number of members last year and would encourage members to use it for renewing their 2012 membership. Information on how to join online is available on the Cycling Ireland website www.cyclingireland.ie/Key-Documents/New-Club-and-Members-Forms.aspx
- 2** Use the Bray Wheelers application form enclosed. Just choose the license which you feel suits the type of activities you will be engaged in (see list of fees below) and enclose payment, in favour of Bray Wheelers (please don't make your cheque out to Cycling Ireland!). If its your first license you will need to supply
 - a)** a photocopy (as it will not be returned) of birth cert, drivers license or passport
NB: Please remember to sign the back of the form
 - b)** If you are under 18 years of age, have a guardian give consent also

Club competition	€60
Restricted competition	€90
Full competition senior and veteran	€125
Non-competition Youth U10 (born on or after 1st January 2002)	€5
Full competition Youth U12, U14 (born in 1998, 1999, 2000 or 2001)	€5
Full competition Youth U16 (born in 1996 or 1997)	€35
Full competition Junior (born in 1994 or 1995)	€50
Overseas Authorisation (note 3)	€20

Notes

- 1** Introductory €15 non-competition membership for new Cycling Ireland members (will then revert to non-competition fee in subsequent years).
- 2** A refund of 50% of the membership fee paid is given to all full-time third level students who are not in receipt of a salary. This must be claimed in writing and a copy of a 2011 student ID card attached.
- 3** A member requesting overseas authorisation must clearly indicate this on their application form. Please note that all applicants for overseas authorisation must submit via email a digital passport-style photograph. A fee of €20 will apply.
